# Household Well Water Testing

## Virginia Household Water Quality Program

### Week of November 4, 2024

November 5 @ 12:00pm

**Return water samples**  
November 6  
7:30am-9:30am

Participants must attend one 30-minute kick-off event to receive sampling information and their testing kits on either November 4<sup>th</sup> at 9:00am or November 5<sup>th</sup> at 12:00pm or 5:30pm. Then, participants collect water samples the morning of Wednesday, November 6<sup>th</sup> and deliver them to the Greenville/Emporia Extension office between 7:30am and 9:30am. **Sample kits dropped off after 9:30am will not be transported to the lab.** Water is analyzed on the Virginia Tech campus for 14 parameters. Results will be available around mid-December. The cost per kit is \$70.00.

First-time participants from Greenville and Emporia are eligible for one free sponsored sample kit per household courtesy of the Chowan Basin Soil and Water Conservation District. (10 sponsored kits are available on a first come, first served basis.) Mention the Soil and Water sponsorship when registering to secure a free kit, if eligible. Additional kits per household and kits for people residing in homes outside of Greenville/Emporia will pay \$70.00 per kit. Once all free sponsored kits are claimed for first-time participants, the \$70.00 fee will be charged per kit for all registrants.



Registration begins October 1, 2024. The registration deadline is October 25<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Cash and checks accepted in person at the Greenville/Emporia Extension office. To register and pay with a credit card, visit <https://register.ext.edu>. Payment is due at the time of registration. No exceptions.

A \$50.00 fee will be charged for all returned checks.
